

NCSES Table Builder: Save and Open Table Definitions



Save time or share work by saving a table definition file to your local device for personal use or collaboration.

How to **SAVE** a table definitions file:

1. Go to the NCSES Table Builder: <https://ncsesdata.nsf.gov/builder/welcome>
2. Select the survey to begin.
3. Build your table by selecting at least one measure and one or more dimensions from the left-side panel.
4. Click on the left-side panel.
5. Click on the pop-up window.
6. Your table definition file automatically saves to your browser's default downloads folder.
7. Share your table with others!

Tip!

You can rename your file after it has downloaded.

How to **OPEN** a table definitions file:

1. Download the JSON file to your device.
2. Go to the NCSES Table Builder: <https://ncsesdata.nsf.gov/builder/welcome>
3. Select the survey to begin.
4. Click on the left-side panel.
5. Click on the pop-up window.
6. Browse to and select the table definitions file and click Open.
7. The Table Builder will provide a preview of your table selections.
